

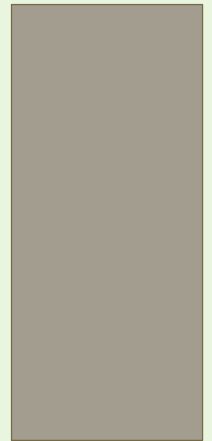

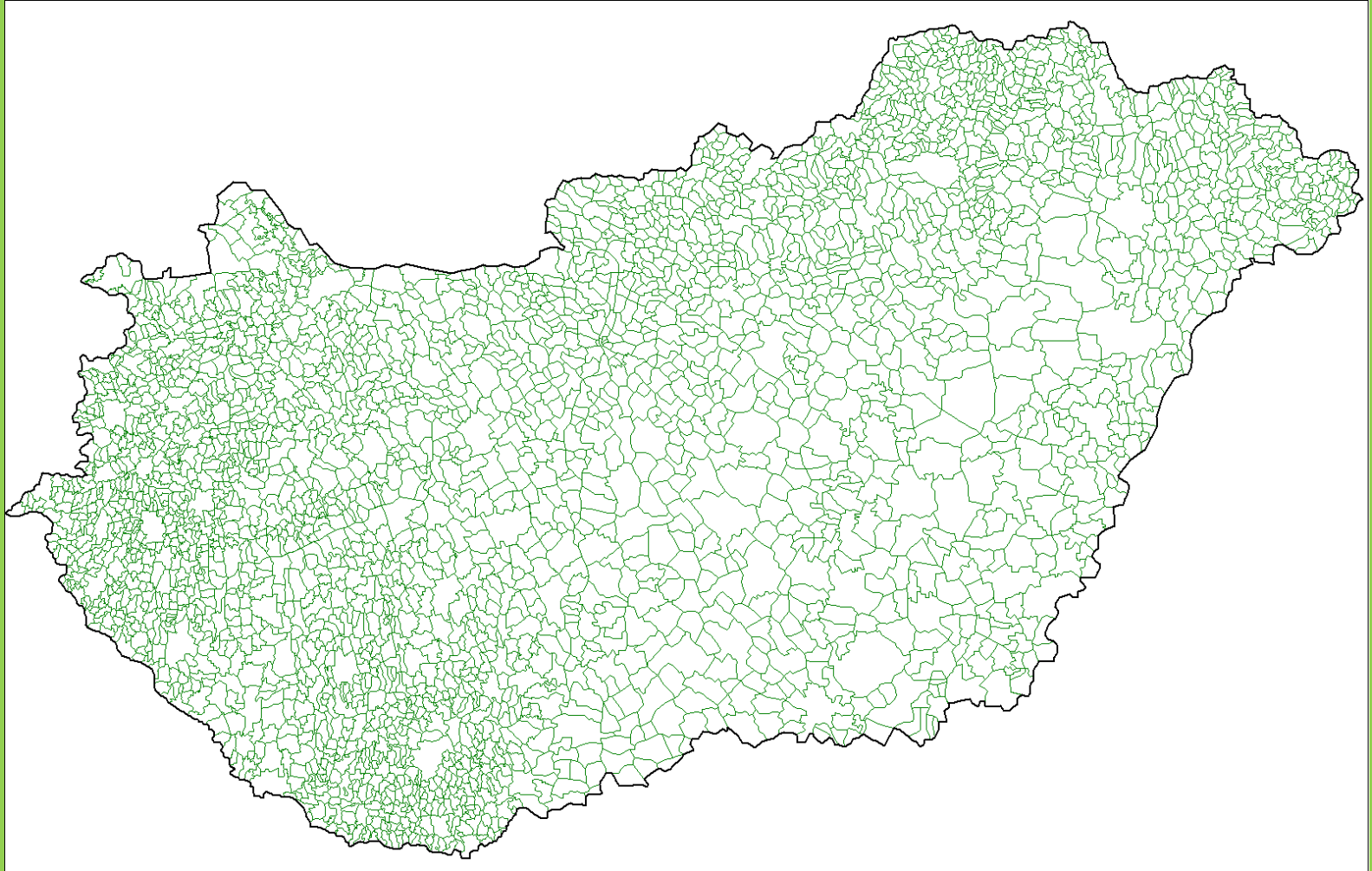

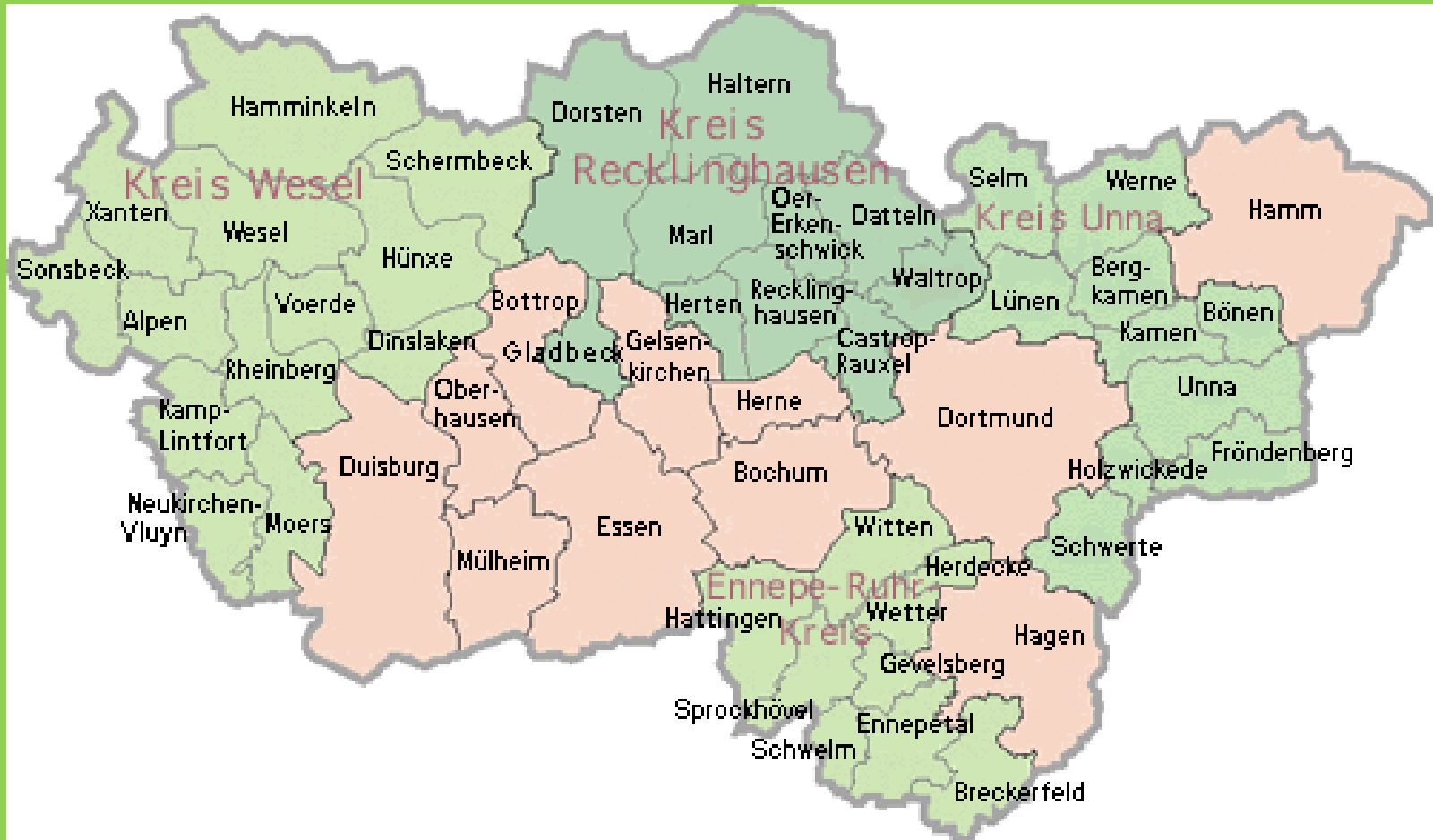
HUNGARIAN MUNICIPALITIES



MECKLENBURG-VORPOMMERN



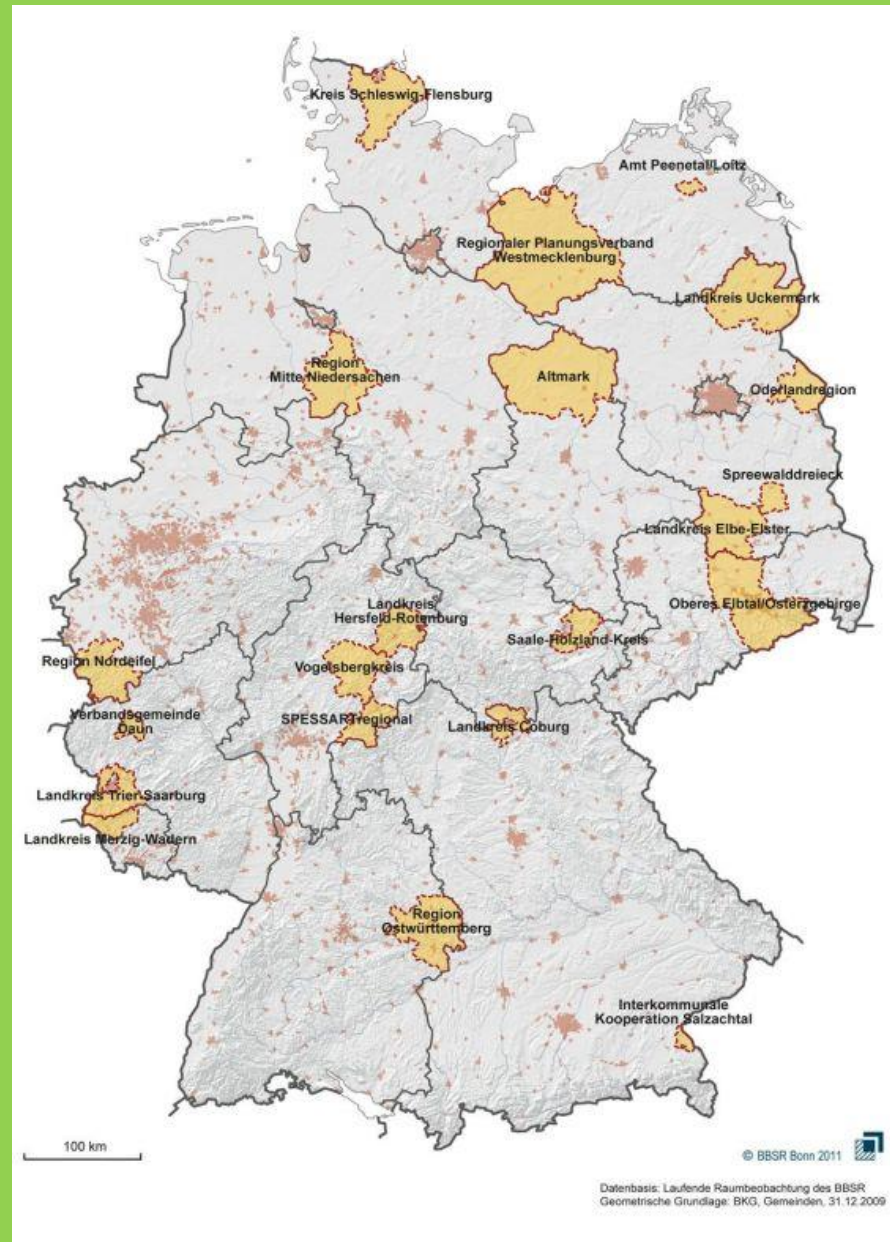

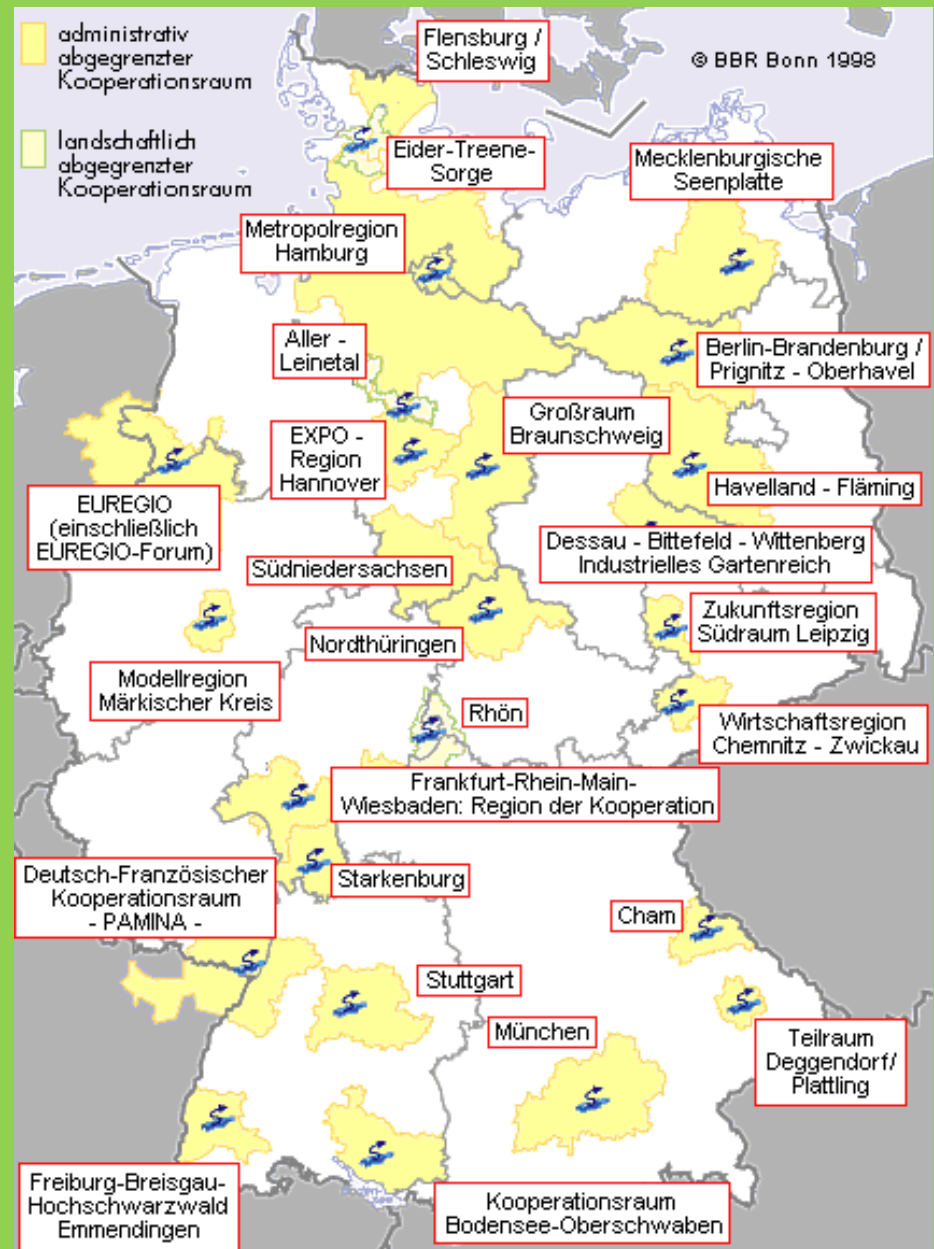
COOPERATION COMPETITIONS

- Federal state has no legal competence to influence local planning, but seeks to influence processes
- It provides competitions for chosen regions in special thematic areas
- The regions have to define their borders, institutions and goals by their own
